**We rely on you to bring forward your concerns and views. If you have concerns about a project, you can send us a Statement of Concern within 30 days of the application being filed with the Canada Energy Regulator (CER). Your concerns will guide the CER in planning its review.**

Statements of concern are for **new applications** for proposed energy projects with the CER. However, if you have concerns about an existing energy project, such as levels of noise, and you are unable to resolve them with the company, refer to the CER's complaint resolution process (<https://www.cer-rec.gc.ca/complaints>).

This form can be completed electronically or you can print a copy of the form and complete it legibly in writing. See Part D below for instructions on how to file your completed form.
